Thank you for volunteering your time as an AYSO referee. The AYSO National Referee Program is designed to provide training to referees and prospective referees that will allow them to referee an AYSO soccer match under FIFA Laws of the Game and the AYSO National Rules and Regulations. With the exception of training for U-8 Officials (modules 1 - 7), referee designation and training are not directly associated with any specific age group. It is obvious that to effectively referee higher level games a referee must have experience, physical conditioning and mental preparation, as well as training. Training in AYSO is a continual process. Referees are encouraged to take additional courses and attend other training modules regardless of whether or not they intend to upgrade.
